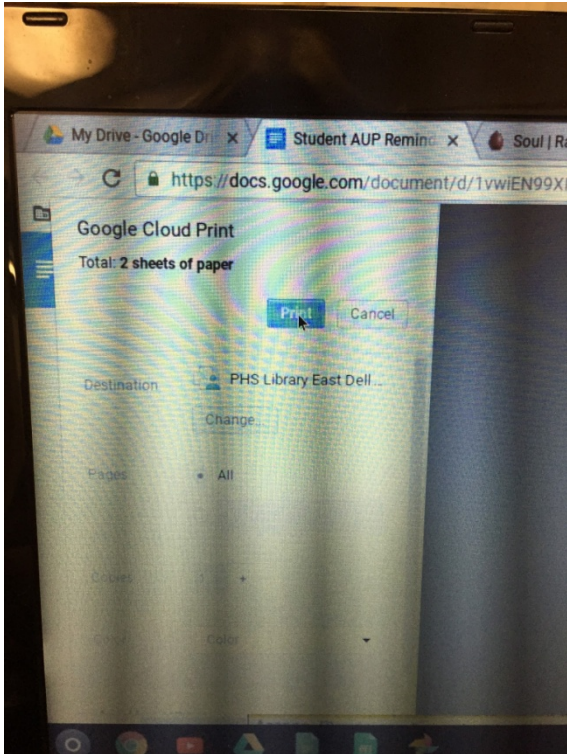
You can then close the cloud printing tutorial.
