Applications for the grant of available equipment should be submitted only by a representative from an HLC member library via the application form on this website. Applications will be reviewed by the HLC Council and requests awarded by majority vote based on merit.

Libraries accepting the equipment will be responsible for any costs associated with configuring the equipment to make it suitable for the intended purpose—i.e., purchasing an operating system for refurbished laptops, etc.
