

In order to properly use the Facebook `Like` feature in Enterprise/Portfolio, you need to create yourself an Facebook App ID and enter it into Enterprise/Portfolio. The first step is creating an App ID:

1. Create a Facebook App by logging in to Facebook, then going to <http://developers.facebook.com/setup>.
2. If you have not previously registered, there will be a bar asking if you wish to register as a developer.
 - A. Click on the "Register Now" Button
 - B. In the pop-up window that will be generated, slide the button from No to Yes.
 - C. The next pop-up will indicate that you are now registered. Click "Done".
3. Once in the Developer interface, Click on Apps, in the blue bar near the top
4. Click on "Add a New App"
5. This will cause a pop-up window to appear. Select "Website" (the circle with the "www" in it).
6. In the Quickstart window type, click on "Skip Quickstart"
 - A. In the new pop-up window type the Display Name for the app.
 - B. The Namespace is optional but should be between 8 to 20 characters, if you choose to use it.
 - C. For the question "Is this a test version of another app?" keep that on "No".
 - D. From Category, select a category.
 - E. Click on Create App
 - F. There will be a security check, before the app is created.
7. Once the App ID is created, before you use it, go to Settings.
8. In Settings, add a valid email address to the App information, then save changes.
9. Go to Status & Review. Here you, near the top of the page is "Do you want to make this app and all its live features available to the general public?", shift this button to "Yes".
10. Go to the Dashboard. This is where the App ID will be displayed. Use this number in Enterprise to enable the "Like" button feature.

Next you will want to add the Facebook App ID to your Enterprise Profile(s):

1. From the Admin console, choose Manage Profiles.
2. For the profile you want to work with, choose Edit.
3. Under "Search Options," select the Enable Facebook 'Like' Button field.
4. In the Facebook App ID field, enter your site's Facebook app ID.
5. Save your changes.
6. Click Refresh Cache.
