PUBLIC LIBRARY USERS GROUP MEETING

TUESDAY, April 30 @ 10:00 AM

The meeting was called to order by Cindi Wynia.

Peton Nielsen conducted a demo of the Envisionware Mobile Print product. The product does not require any additional equipment. It will work with computers and printers we already own. There are 3 methods for patrons to send print jobs; web portal, via an email address, and by using the mobile print app (free). All 3 are available to the libraries and patrons with the subscription. Three libraries are currently using the product. Envisionware will offer competitive pricing. Troyce will be getting more info.

The virtual card in the Cloud Library was discussed. A 2D scanner is required to scan the patron's phone; although the printed # can be typed without any problems. If a patron has a problem getting the new updated cloud library app, suggest that they delete the app, turn off the phone, then reinstall the app after the phone is turned back on.

April Dillion mentioned that TLA conference had several sessions about collaborating with different types of libraries. i.e. what HLC has been doing since the 80's. There was discussion about partnering with SCLRT, District 2, Tocker, TSL, and or the program committee to present a session about HLC. There was also discussion about approaching Tocker to chair a booth space (they share a booth with CTLS). There will be more discussion of this at HUG.

Troyce asked the group to take time with their staff to look at all the gadgets in Workflows and determine if there more user friendly names that could be used i.e. check in to replace discharge. This will be voted on by the group in the fall so we have all summer to get input.

There was a question about credit accounts in workflows. This is configured for each Library, if you would like to set it up contact Troyce.
