PUBLIC LIBRARY INTEREST GROUP MEETING (PLIG)

TUESDAY, OCTOBER 22, 2019

The meeting was called to order by Vicki Decker at 10:03 a.m. Minutes of the last meeting were read and approved as read on a motion by Amanda, seconded by Sandra Sears.

Old Business:

- 1. PrinterOn has been installed at Collingsworth and other public libraries. Print option available from phone or tablet. It is somewhat slow, but doing well. The speed could be slow internet issue.**
- 2. "How much you saved" will be available on printer receipt after upgrades are in place. Not sure when WorkFlows will upgrade yet.**
- 3. Sara Hayes -ILL visits are not currently scheduled at this point. Amanda Barrera will check on this.**
- 4. Census taking in the library was discussed. The process takes about 10 Minutes.**
- 5. Troyce is cleaning up duplicate user records and duplicate item records. She has found brief records when full records were there first. Search for records by author, title, and ISBN. If everything matches except the ISBN, attach the item then give Troyce the ISBN and she will add it to the record.**

New Business:

- 1. Work is being done on the TSLAC E-Read Texas program, an effort to get e-books to smaller rural libraries. The SimplyE app will be available first to libraries that use Apollo ILS. Troyce will contact Amigos to see what the cost will be to access the ebooks prior to the software working with our Sirsi ILS.**
- 2. Defensive Driving- DVD courses are extinct. Users can use the website, www.Idrivesafely.com.**
- 3. Libraries and the First Amendment: we need to be aware that people are videoing what goes on in libraries in some instances. Libraries should be privacy guarded, but remember you are a public servant. Those videoing (auditing) what goes on MAY harass users and/or employees. Be sure you have a Code of Conduct in place to deal with any ill behavior.**
- 4. Fair Use for Copyright- refresher course is available; article in Texas Library Journal.**
- 5. State Library- Summer Reading Program will be available soon. Deadline for ordering materials is November 20, 2019.**
- 6. A to Z University Webinar-Jordan LaBorde. Job and resume may be separate. Troyce will email login information for trial.**
